Bio hin

Kitchen waste and food leftovers of vegetable and animal origin (raw and cooked):

- Meat, fish, fruit and vegetables
- Bread and bakery products
- Coffee, tea, coffee and tea filters, coffee pods
- Garden waste (up to 1cm in diameter)*.
- Cut flowers

Glass

• Newspaper and kitchen roll*



Items that cannot be recycled, e.g.:

- Hygiene articles (toothbrush, cotton swabs, diapers, tampons, sanitary napkins)
- Ash, sweepings, vacuum cleaner bags
- Dried emulsion paint
- Cat litter, small animal litter
- Halogen lamps
- Heat-resistant glass (drinking glass, glass jugs, casserole dishes, etc.)
- Baking paper, soiled papers (pizza boxes, handkerchiefs)
- Worn/damaged textiles and toys
- Cigarettes, cigarette ends



Paper and cardboard:

- Newspapers, magazines, catalogs
- Books without cover
- Writing paper
- Envelopes (incl. windows)
- Clean packaging made of paper, cardboard or carton (folded)
- Paper bags
- Egg cartons, flour and sugar bags
- Pizza boxes without food waste





- Disposable glass bottles
- Small cosmetic bottles etc. made of glass
- Packaging glass (e.g. from jam, mustard, pickles, sauces, etc.)



Rinsing is not necessary!

- plastic or metal:Bottles (denosit free
- Plastic cups and howls (remove lids)
- Tetrapack
- Cans, spray cans
- Aluminum and composite packaging (e.g. butter foil, medicine blisters, etc.)
- Plastic and metal tubes (e.g. mustard tubes or toothpaste)
- Stvrofoan
- Plastic bags, bubble wrap
- Crown cap:
- Aluminum, tin and plastic lids
- Metal foils (e.g. aluminum foil)
- Plastic or metal coffee capsules (empty)
